


The Emergence of Convergence With the Secure Access Service Edge (SASE)



Hype Cycle for Network Security, 2020






Multi-pass vs. Single-pass Architecture





Global SASE Service PoPs






Just plug into the nearest SASE PoP to get the <u>same</u> performance, security, capacity, and availability - <u>everywhere</u>


